## About Performance Class:

Performance Class is held twice annually, and provides students with development of performance and acting skills as they relate to song. The primary focus varies from student to student, depending upon their level of development. The environment is supportive, and creates a comfortable setting in which to experiment with challenging performance issues away from the formal concert venue. Students will perform their piece from memory, and should be prepared to work on all aspects of their performance for the class. If the piece is in a language other than English, a close word for word translation should be prepared.

Each year, we have a large number of college and college bound students and will divide the class into high school and college levels respectively. If a student's schedule requires that they perform earlier or later during the class, please let us know and we will accommodate you.



## Cost:

The cost of the class is \$80.00. Students must have their checks in by Friday, July 2nd to register for the class. Cancellation with refund is possible prior to Saturday, July 17<sup>th</sup>. After July 17<sup>th</sup>, a refund is not possible.
